Tree Frogs
4 species photted in Glenwood area
Green, Rubby, Eastern dwarf, Graceful. 1
species see Tyler's
Habitat: tree hollows, forests, rock
crevices under bark, broad leaved plants
with capable holding moisture, low
vegetation, swamp area
Diet: small invertebrates insects, spiders
Size: 2- 11cm Green treefrog biggest



Possums and Gliders
5 species photted in Glenwood area
Brush-tail & Ring-tail possum. Squirrel,
Greater Glider, yellow-bellied, 2 species
seen krefft's, feather-tail.
Habitat: P. Eucalypt Forest, woodlands,
rainforest. Hollow-bearing trees
Diet: Eucalypt leaves, fruit, flower,
insects, small animals. G. nectar, pollen,
insects, sap
Size: P. 35-55cm + T. G. 10cm - 45cm + T.



Honeyeater
18 species photted in Glenwood area
Heath, understory near wetlands and
woodlands
Diet: Nectar, insects, spiders, fruit and
berries
Size: 10-25cm



Wallabies / Marsupial
3 Species photted in Glenwood area
Swamp, Whiptail, Red-Necked
Habitat: Eucalypt Forest, Woodlands
Understory/ Scrubs with Grass, Coastal
Heath.
Diet: Grass, Herbs, Shrubbery, Ferns
Average Size: 70cm - 95cm + Tail



Monotremes
2 species photted in Glenwood area
Platypus and Echidna
Habitat: E Rainforest to dry Woodlands P
freshwater, streams, lakes, creeks.
Burrows in banks just above water level
in tree roots.
Diet: E. ants, termites. P. aquatic
invertebrates
Size: E 30-45cm P 55-65cm



Black Cockatoos
3 species photted in Glenwood area Red-
tailed, Yellow-tailed, Glossy (endangered)
Habitat: Tree hollows eucalypt /
Casuarina Forest
Diet: Glossy eat seeds from Casuarina
cones, Red & Yellow nuts, seed, cones
Size: Red & Yellow. 55-65 cm Glossy. 45-
60 cm



Dragon Lizards
3 species Photted in Glenwood area
Eastern Water Dragon, Eastern Bearded
Dragon, Frilled Lizard
Habitat: EWD constant supply of water
creeks, rivers. EBD & FL Forests eucalypt
or woodlands with undergrowth
Diet: insects, spiders, small mammals,
soft fruit and flower
Size: 60cm-75cm 80-90 Frill



Monitors
3 species photted in Glenwood area
Yellow-spotted and Lace Monitor
Habitat: Y. Dry sclerophyll forest and
grassland. L. Eucalypt/ melaleuca forest,
sup tropical rainforest shelter in tree
hollows.
Diet: Bird eggs, turtles, carrion
Size: 1.5 - 2m



Ibis
3 species photted in Glenwood area,
White, Straw-necked, Glossy
Habitat: Wetlands, grasslands,
floodplains
Diet: aquatic and terrestrial invertebrates
Size: 45-76cm
